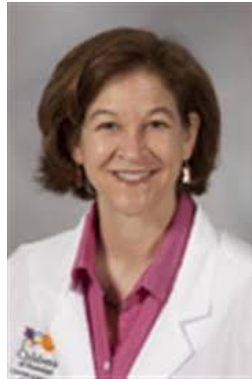


Dr. Melissa McNaull
